

Olive Grove Charter Schools, Inc. High School Course Catalog

The Olive Grove Charter Schools (OGCS) provide personalized learning for the home environment with both virtual and in-person teacher support, counseling, labs, and tutoring. OGCS grade-level course offerings and OGCS graduation requirements align with both California's minimum high school graduation requirements and the State's <u>K-12 Content Standards</u> and <u>Curriculum Frameworks</u>.

Each semester, OGCS students must enroll in a **minimum of four high school courses**, prorated depending on enrollment start date.

The **deadline to drop** most courses without the title appearing on the transcript is the end of the third full week of each semester. This deadline applies regardless of when a student begins enrollment with Olive Grove. For the 2023-24 school year, the course drop deadlines are as follows:

- First semester: September 1, 2023
- Second Semester: January 26, 2024

The deadline to drop all Advanced Placement (AP) and Honors courses (with the exception of Art History and Criticism) is 14 calendar days from the course start date.

Most OGCS high school courses are <u>A-G approved</u> by the University of California (UC) to fulfill UC high school course completion requirements to be eligible for admission to UC and California State University (CSU). This includes **Advanced Placement** (AP) courses which, when scoring a 3 or higher on the AP exam, may meet university requirements dependent upon the respective university's policies. See, for example, <u>UC's policies on AP credits</u>. OGCS offers AP courses via FlexPoint Virtual School. OGCS does not administer AP exams. Students must contact the AP coordinator at a local high school and make arrangements to take the exam(s).

OGCS accepts **transfer credit** from accredited institutions such as public high schools, private schools, and dual enrollment courses offered at California community colleges. OGCS also accepts transfer credit from course taken through online providers accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).

OGCS encourages students to consider **dual enrollment** with one of the many excellent <u>California Community</u> <u>Colleges</u>. Dual enrollment in a California community college allows eligible OGCS high school students to complete college level coursework while earning high school credit in courses that fulfill OGCS high school graduation requirements. OGCS school counselors can assist students and families with college and career pathways including identifying dual-enrollment course options and student financial aid opportunities.

OGCS offers **Credit Recovery** courses in English, Mathematics, and Social Studies. Credit recovery is available when a student did not successfully complete and pass a course in one of the above-mentioned subjects. Credit recovery courses allow a student to test to demonstrate mastery of a unit and progress through the course work at a more rapid pace. Credit recovery courses do not fulfill UC admission requirements but they do meet OGCS and State high school graduation requirements.
